The programme is funded by the Department for Education, using monies from the soft drinks levy, and is being delivered by the charities Family Action and Magic Breakfast. The programme will run until March 2020. The aim is to reach all children and ensure that every child has access to a healthy breakfast at the start of the school day.

As a NSBP school we are pleased to offer a healthy breakfast, available to all, and enjoy the benefits that brings, with children settled and ready to learn at the start of the school day.

Our breakfast club and Earlybirds readers club will remain relatively unchanged, all receiving cereals as well as porridge and now a toasted bagel in place of toasted sliced bread.
