


The capital letter and lower case letter are both code for the /b/ sound as in bat, ball, bag, bucket and belt.

Say each word slowly and focus on the mouth movements for the /b/ sound.




















The capital letter and lower case letter are both code for the /k/ sound as in cat, cup, cloud, crab and castle.


Point under each letter and say /k/. Finger-trace the letter shapes and say /k/. Write the letter shapes 'in the air'.

Say each word slowly and focus on the mouth movements for the /k/ sound.

















The capital letter and lower case letter are both code for the /h/ sound as in hat, hair, hen, hands and horn.

Point under each letter and say /h/. Finger-trace the letter shapes and say /h/. Write the letter shapes 'in the air'.









The capital letter and lower case letter are both code for the /k/ sound as in kit, kettle, kite, king and key.

Point under each letter and say /k/. Finger-trace the letter shapes and say /k/. Write the letter shapes 'in the air'.


