Nut allergy

As of this term we have children in school that suffer from nut allergies and could develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction. If someone has a nut allergy it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock.

Staff in school are already trained in the use of Epi-pens, which are required immediately if a reaction happens.

Please can we ask that you have no nut products in the lunch boxes or brought into school as treats. For example:-Peanut butter sandwiches

Peanut butter sandwiches Coconut Chocolate spread Cereal / granola bars Cakes / Cookies/ Biscuits containing nuts Some Asian food, satay etc

Sauces containing nuts

This list is not exhaustive, so please check the packaging of products closely. We appreciate that this is an additional thing to check but we know that you will recognise the importance of this.
