What do you think the Litter Police would look like? Can you draw and label what you think look like. Use adjectives to describe them.</p>

<b>Music</b>	I can play tuned and untuned instruments musically	Children will be able to play untuned instruments.	Look around your house and look for something to make music with. You could use a pan and spoon, can you try and play a pattern?
