

I can link sounds to letters	Reading a book to your child Reading a book with your child – they may be able to sound out or recognise some words Listening to a book read by your child – they will be able to read most of the book to you but may need support with some words. Literacy – Writing	I can hear the initial sound in words. I can segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together. I can write short sentences. Have a go at sounding out the words using your phonics. If you need a little help, ask a grown up if you can copy underneath their writing.
Mathematics	In practical activities and discussions I can begin to use the vocabulary involved in subtraction.	Children to have an understanding of subtraction.
