Can you use google and find some photographs of volcanoes? Can you make a volcano? You could use boxes to make a model, draw a picture or you could use newspaper to make a cone and paint it, like the photo shows.</p>

Choose something to collage your dinosaur pants with it could be paper, material, cotton wool or glitter. Will they be soft, hard, shiny or bumpy? Can you make a dinosaur picture using dried pasta?
