






English – Reading	<p>I can apply phonic knowledge to decode words.</p> <p>I can respond speedily with the correct sound to graphemes (letters or groups of letters) for all 40+ phonemes</p> <p>I can read accurately by blending sounds in unfamiliar words containing GPCs that have been taught.</p>	<p>Log into the Oxford Owls page.
