I can link sounds to letters	Reading a book to your child Practise your letter sounds M,d,g,o	Practise the letters m, d, g, o Look at the sound; can you talk about what objects begin with that letter sound?
Literacy – Writing	I am beginning to write my own name.	To begin to write letters from my name independently.	Can you practise writing your name? You could use different materials. Sand, paint, shaving foam. 
Mathematics	I show an interest in number problem. I can find the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them.	To begin to solve simple number problems with support. .	The Very Hungry Caterpillar eats 2 pears and 3 plums. How many pieces of fruit did he eat altogether? You use fingers or draw a picture to help you.

Understanding the World	I can talk about some of the things I have observed such as animals, natural and found objects.	To go on a mini-beast hunt and record findings.	Take a walk around a garden, park or outside. What minibeast can you find? Try looking under plant pots or stones. You could draw a picture or take a photo of what you find.
