Dear Parents/Carers

Due to the rise in covid-19 in our area we are asking parents to take children for a PCR test if they are showing any signs of Covid-19.

These symptoms can include continuous cough, high temperature, loss of taste and smell, diarrhoea, fever, headache, skin rash and shortness of breath,

Other symptoms listed by the experts and attributed to the Delta Plus variant are: stomach ache, nausea and appetite loss.

What to do if your child has symptoms

Get a PCR test (test that is sent to a lab) to check if they have Covid-19 as soon as possible

You, your child and anyone else you live with should stay at home and not have visitors until you get the test results- only leave your home to have the test.

Anyone in your childcare or support bubble should also stay at home if your child has been in close contact with them since their symptoms started or during the 48 hours before they started.

May we also remind you that all adults must wear a face mask on site unless they are medically exempt.
