


<p>You should already know the names of some of the People who help us. Police, fire, teacher, dentist, doctor, nurse and vet. Some children may be able to discuss what these people do.</p> 	<p>Emergency Services - People who deal with problems Ambulance - A vehicle that takes people to and from the hospital Fire Engine - Vehicle that has lots of equipment to help put out fires Hospital - A large building where people go to get better Emergency – A sudden serious or dangerous event which needs immediate action to deal with it. Rescue - Saving somebody who is in danger Assistance Help or support</p>	<p>Vet - People who make poorly animals better. Police - People who help the community to stay safe. Firefighter - People who put out fires. Doctor - Someone who makes us feel better. Dentist – Someone who makes our teeth better. Optician – Someone who makes our eyes better. Lifeguard - A person who is a really good swimmer who can save people in the water. Paramedic - People who come out to help you in an emergency.</p>
