Can you discuss with your child the job of a doctor? Have they ever been to the doctors? What for? How did they doctor help them? Discuss some of the vocabulary in the story. What is a vaccination? What is an operation? How do the doctors in the story help the characters?

Can your child have a go at being a doctor? What would you ask the patient? How would you treat them?

Can your child have a go at painting or drawing the character Zog?
