I can use my phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds.	Children to write a caption or phrase using their phonics.	Can you watch the story 'Alien Tea on Planet Zum Zee' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9lxwe0sTfrl Can you write a list of food you would take to a tea party? You could also draw pictures of the food. (Include 3 or more items in your list and think about why you have chosen the food)
Mathematics	I can recognise and order numerals 1 – 5. I can identify and write missing numbers to 10	Children to recognise and order numerals 1 – 5. Children to identify and write missing numbers to 10	Ask your grown up to help you make some number cards to 10. (Cut up some paper and write one number on each piece.) Task – put the number cards 1 – 5 in the right order then continue with 6 – 10.

			Grown-ups – can you take some numbers away and ask your children to put them back in the right place.
Expressive Arts & Design	I can create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.	Children to make a name rocket.	 <p>Use coloured paper or white paper and coloured pencils/crayons. Cut the paper into squares and write the letters from your name on the squares. Can you put them together to make a rocket? Can children develop their cutting skills by using scissors independently?</p>
