<p>In our Literacy lessons we are going to be using stories to help us with our writing. Children will be taught to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• write sentences by saying out loud what they are going to write about• composing a sentence orally before writing it• sequencing sentences to form short narratives• re-reading what they have written to check that it makes sense• discuss what they have written with the teacher or other pupils• read aloud their writing clearly enough to be heard by their peers and the teacher.	<p>Tricky Words</p> <p>said have like so do some come little one were there what when out</p>	<p>In our Maths lessons we are going to be focusing on fluency and trying to improve our understanding of numbers. Children will be taught to:</p> <p><u>Geometry – Shape:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognise 3D solids-cuboids, spheres, and pyramids.• Describe position, direction and movement including whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns. <p><u>Number – Addition and Subtraction</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts (within 20)• Add and subtract 1 digit numbers to 20 including zero• To solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems• Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving +, - and = <p><u>Number – Place Value</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Count to 20, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number• Count, read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words• To identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least• Count in multiples of 2's and 5's
