As part of Year 2's topic 'Scrumdiddlyumptious' we have organised a visit to Pontefract Castle to take part in a Liquorice Workshop on Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> May. The workshop will involve finding out about the history of liquorice in Pontefract and where it was grown.

The children will also be making their own maps of the castle grounds as part of our Geography work. We will be looking at where the Haribo factory is located and how it has changed over time. Children will also have the opportunity to visit the Haribo shop and to purchase a bag of sweets.

We will be catching the train from Featherstone in the morning and making our way straight to the castle where one group will take part in the workshop and the other will complete the mapping activity and Haribo shop visit.
