Put on your favourite song and make up your own moves to dough disco. e.g. – squeeze, pinch, pull, roll, twist etc.  Can you write your full name holding your pencil correctly? Can you write the letters of the alphabet? Can you write numbers 1-10?
<b>Literacy – Reading</b>	I can listen to stories with increasing attention and recall. I can hear the initial sound in words. I can segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together.
