

The National Curriculum teacher assessments and/or tests are designed to give you and your child's school information about how well your child is doing.

Key Stage 1 teacher assessments, tasks and tests

Teacher assessment for seven year olds covers:

- reading
- writing
- speaking and listening
- maths
- science

These **assessments** take account of how your child performed in Key Stage 1 tasks and tests for seven year olds. The tasks and tests cover:

- reading
- writing (including handwriting and spelling)
- maths

The tasks and tests can be taken at a time the school chooses. They last for less than three hours altogether. The results are not reported separately but are used to help the teacher assess your child's work. By the age of seven, most children are expected to achieve level Expected (EXS) with some achieving Greater Depth (GDS)

The teacher assessment is moderated by your local authority. This is to make sure teachers make consistent assessments of children's work.

When comparing three year trend figures we must remember the impact that the time out of school due to the pandemic means the data figures show a decline for both school and national.

The recovery curriculum put in place will address this over the next two years.
