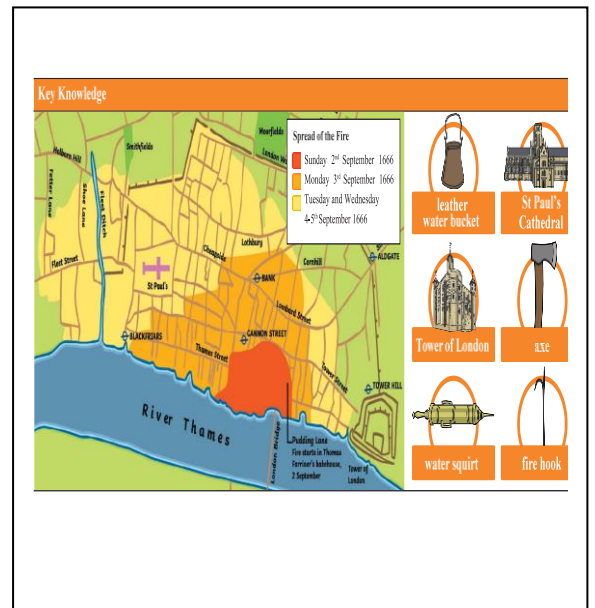
Year 2 History - The Great Fire of London
